

UK Cancer Information Service Release Notes June 2010

The June 2010 release contains the following new features:

Data up to 2007 Incidence, 2008 Mortality, 2007 Survival (followed-up to the end of 2008).
UK version (including updated help text)
Data for Northern Ireland, Wales and Scotland in addition to England with Country, Great Britain and UK aggregations.
For sex specific cancer sites example: Prostate cancer; only data for males would be displayed. For Breast cancer only data for males and females (separately) will be displayed.
County level data is now available in the Government Office Region (GOR) structure.
C44 Other malignant neoplasms of Skin is now included for Mortality module.
New aggregations: C23-C24 (Gallbladder and other and unspecified parts of biliary tract), CWT: C40-41+C46+C48-49 (Sarcoma) CWT: C81-85+C88+C90-96 (Haematological).
Latest National Life tables from London School of Hygiene and Tropical Medicine (LSHTM).
